Goal Four: Brand and Develop South Dakota's Quality of Life as the Best in America by 2010 (all % changes are annual)

4A. Enhance South Dakota's image to young people to become an importer of young people

The **Dakota Corps Scholarship** program became operational in the fall of 2004 when scholarships were awarded to 42 South Dakota high school students and 42 scholarships were awarded to students already attending a South Dakota university.

In 2005, the Dakota Corps Scholarship program awarded 28 scholarships to incoming freshmen and 6 students already attending a South Dakota university.

In 2006, the Dakota Corps Scholarship program awarded 20 scholarships to incoming freshmen.

In 2007, the Dakota Corps Scholarship program awarded 24 scholarships to incoming freshmen.

In 2008, the Dakota Corps Scholarship program awarded 60 scholarships to incoming freshmen.

In 2009, the Dakota Corps Scholarship program awarded 49 scholarships to incoming freshmen.
